1. Petition from James and Gloria A. Maron, 180 Button Hole Drive, Providence, Rhode Island 02909, requesting to abandon Treasea Street.
2. Petition of Peter Marinucci, Lillian Marinucci and Anthony Marinucci by their Attorney, John B. Ennis, Esquire, relative to Resolution No. 282, approved April 21, 1987 informing the same is hereby rescinded.
3. Resolution Requesting the abandonment of certain lots located at the intersection of Niagara Street, Early Street, Cadillac Drive and Rodman Street, located in the Elmwood Neighborhood, be merged with abutting property located at 38 Rodman Street (Plat 53, Lot 480), and transferred to the Parks Department for use as a permanent community garden.
4. Resolution Requesting to Reconsider Resolution No. 98, Approved March 11, 2009, relative to the abandonment of a paper street at the corner of Coggeshall Street and Newcomb Street.
5. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Old Road to be designated as a "One-Way" Street from Mount Pleasant Avenue to Smith Street.
6. Resolution Requesting that Lexington Avenue, between Niagara Street and Broad Street (in the direction of Niagara heading to Broad), be established as a "One-Way" between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 6:00 o'clock P.M.
7. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to designate that area located along Pleasant Valley Parkway from Garfield Avenue to Oakland Avenue as a "No Parking Zone", on both sides.
