3. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a "Stop" Sign on Pleasant Street at the corner of Hopedale Road.
4. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of speed signs along Highland Avenue.
5. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Four-Way Stop" Signs at Ocean Street and Potters Avenue.
6. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a "No Parking To Corner" Sign on Fourth Street at the junction with North Main Street.
7. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a "Stop" Sign at the intersection of Argol Street and Edgeworth Avenue, with the sign being installed on the Argol Street side.
8. Resolution requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of Two (2) "Slow Children" Signs at both ends of Manila Street.

The planted strip along Thayer would be raised 8" with a granite curb to separate the raised planted strip from the sidewalk.
