BUDGET BRIEFING

Richard Kerbel, Director of Administration, invited for Budget Presentation relative to the following ordinances:

An Ordinance Providing for the Assessment and Collection of 2010 taxes in a sum not less than Two Hundred Seventy Six Million One Hundred Two Thousand Dollars (\$276,102,000.00) and not more than Three Hundred Two Million, Six Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars (\$302,689,600.00) being based on a One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year Tax Collections, Amending Section 21-182 of the Code of Ordinances to reflect the Tax Collection Classification Plan approved by the Rhode Island General Assembly, Amending Section 21-126 of the Code of Ordinances to raise the personal exemptions, and setting the homestead rates for Fiscal Year 2011.

An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 2009-51, No. 387, Approved September 8, 2009, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Making an Appropriation of Six Hundred Thirty Nine Million, One Hundred Forty Two Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty Three Dollars (\$639,142,963), for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2011, As Amended.

An Ordinance Establishing a Compensation Plan for the City of Providence and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2009-52, No. 388, Approved September 8, 2009, As Amended.

An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in certain classes in the City Departments and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2009-53, No. 389, Approved September 8, 2009, As Amended.
