1. An Ordinance Requiring the City Treasurer to verify that all expenditures are authorized through an appropriation by the City Council, specified through a duly approved ordinance before any disbursement of city funds.
2. Resolution Requesting to apply the Homestead Exemption to the property located on Assessor's Plat 49, Lot 236 (19 Stanwood Street) and to abate any and all outstanding taxes on behalf of the Elmwood Foundation. (
3. Resolution Requesting to apply the Homestead Exemption to the property located on Assessor's Plat 117, Lot 112 (40 Sharon Street) for the year 2006 and to abate any and all outstanding taxes.

6. Resolution Requesting the Tax Assessor to abate the taxes on Assessor's Plat 48, Lot 211 (301 Swan Street), as requested by Habitat for Humanity of Rhode Island, Inc.
7. Resolution Requesting the Tax Assessor to abate the taxes on Assessor's Plat 47, Lot 685 (11 Trask Street), as requested by Habitat for Humanity of Rhode Island, Inc.
8. Resolution Requesting the Tax Assessor to abate the taxes on Assessor's Plat 44, Lot 25 (577 Public Street), as requested by Habitat for Humanity of Rhode Island, Inc.
9. Resolution Requesting to cancel or abate the remainder of the taxes assessed upon Assessor's Plat 45, Lot 903 (19 Saint James Street), in the amount of Two Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Five Dollars and Sixty Six (\$2,355.66) Cents, plus any and all accrued interest, as requested by Peoples Redevelopment Corporation.
