1. An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 2008-43, No. 381, Approved October 8, 2008, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, making an Appropriation of Six Hundred Twenty Three Million, One Hundred Sixty One Thousand, Six Hundred and One Dollars (\$623,161,601) for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2012, As Amended.
2. An Ordinance Establishing a Compensation Plan for the City of Providence and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2008-42, No. 380, Approved October 8, 2008, As Amended.
3. An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the Maximum Number of Employees and the number of Employees in certain classes in the City Departments and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2008-44, No. 382, Approved October 8, 2008, As Amended.
4. An Ordinance Providing for the Assessment and Collection of 2009 taxes in a sum not less than Two Hundred Seventy Million Dollars (\$270,000,000.00), and not more than Two Hundred Ninety-Six Million (\$296,000,000.00), being based on a One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 2009-2010 Fiscal Year Tax Collections, Amending Section 21-182 of the Code of Ordinances to reflect the Tax Classification Plan approved by the Rhode Island General Assembly, Amending Section 21-126 of the Code of Ordinances to raise the Personal Exemptions and setting the Homestead rates for Fiscal Year 2010.
