CHAPTER

No. **AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ARTICLE IV, CHAPTER 17, SECTION 17-192(F) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES (DISABILITY WAIVER REQUEST)**

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the language of Section 17-189(6) of the Code of Ordinances which provides that the application to accomplish such [accidental disability] retirement must be filed within eighteen (18) months of the date of the accident,” the Retirement Board of the City of Providence, may consider and act upon the accidental disability retirement application of Sugar Rodriguez, even though more than eighteen (18) months have passed since the date of the accident which is the averred proximate cause of the above-named applicant for a disability retirement allowance.

SECTION 2. Said application shall be subject to and considered in accordance with all other applicable ordinances, regulations, standards and practices relating to accidental disability retirement applications.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the taxes in the amount of \$157,151.24 (One Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand, One Hundred Fifty-One and 24/100 Dollars), assessed upon 1017 Broad Street and 17 Warrington Street, Assessors Plat: 053 Lots 582 and 619, Providence, RI 02905, along with any associated and/or intervening interest, penalties and taxes are hereby abated in whole and that the property is declared exempt, in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 45-32-40, while it was under Agency ownership.
