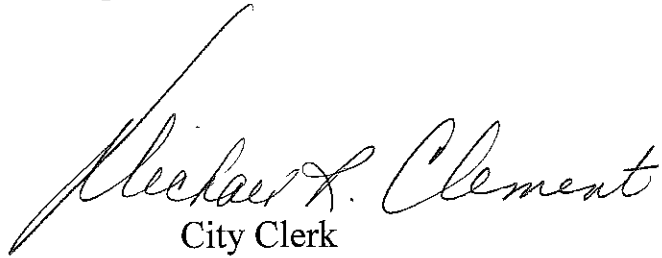
The Medical Disability Sub-Committee of the Employees' Retirement System met this day at 9:00 o'clock a.m., in the City Council Chambers, City Hall.
