The Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning meets this day upon the rise of the City Council Meeting, which adjourned at 7:50 o'clock P.M.

PRESENT: Councilwoman Josephine DiRuzzo, Chairman, Councilmen O'Connor, Dillon, Lopes, Rollins and Michael R. Clement, Assistant Clerk.

Chairwoman DiRuzzo informs the members of the committee that she has called this meeting in order that we can clear up some of these matters which have been in committee for some time; the majority of the items were introduced by former council members and have been sitting in committee.

RELATIVE TO:

An ordinance amending Article IV, Section 23-81 (c) and 23-81 (f) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence.

On motion of Councilman O'Connor and seconded by Councilman Dillon, it is voted that the said Ordinance be continued for further study and requested that Mr. Anthony A. Giannini, Deputy City Solicitor, research the matter further and report back to this Committee.

An Ordinance in Amendment of and in addition to Chapter 1983-19 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence approved May 3, 1983 and entitled, "An Ordinance approving and adopting The Official Redevelopment Plan for the Trinity Gateway Revitalization Project for Project Boundary Revision."

An Ordinance in amendment of and in addition to Chapter 1973-52 of the Ordinances of The City of Providence approved December 24, 1973 and entitled, "An Ordinance approving and adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for West Broadway NDP Urban Renewal Area (1). Resolution changing the address of 51 Silver Spring Street to One Silver Spring Street.

Resolution Recommending to the Committee on Naming of Buildings, Expressways, Bridges, Edifices and Other City Constructions, that the Building located at 209 Fountain Street, commonly known as the Police and Fire Headquarters Building, be Designated as "Colonel Walter A. McQueeney Memorial Building".

Resolution Recommending the Committee on Naming of Buildings, Edifices and other City Construction to Change the Name of Prairie Avenue to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.

Resolution requesting the Committee on Naming of Buildings, Expressways, Bridges, Edifices and Other City Constructions, to Change the Name of the Providence Junior Police Camp to "Cronin Marine Learning Center."

Resolution Requesting the Committee on Naming of Buildings, Expressways, Bridges, Edifices and Other City Constructions to Name that Area located at Eaton Street and Smith Street as "Anthony S. Zavota Memorial Plaza."

Resolution Designating and Dedicating the Intersection of Reservoir Avenue and Downing Street as "Stephen D. Bradley Memorial Square."

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Resolution Requesting the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning to Change the Name of Lower Pine Street, from the Intersection of Pine and Dyer Streets to the Area from the intersection of Pine and Dyer streets to the area where Friendship and Richmond Street join, to Courthouse Row.

Resolution Requesting the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning to Change the Name of Service Road No. 3 to Messiah Place.

Resolution Requesting the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning to Change the Name of Barberry Hill Street to Barberry Hill.

Resolution Requesting that Westminster Street from its intersection with Market Square to its intersection with Dorrance Street be re-named Verrazzano Way.

Resolution Designating the Pleasant View School for Handicapped Children as "Jerry Lorenzo Memorial School."

Resolution Requesting the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning to Change the Name of Africa Street to Aglione Street.

Resolution Requesting the Department of Public Buildings to provide plaques for dedication of the various Fire Stations to be named after those Firefighters who have laid down their lives in the line of duty.

Resolution Requesting the Providence Redevelopment Agency to undertake an Urban Renewal Project along Adelaide Avenue between Broad Street and Elmwood Avenue.

Resolution Authorizing His Honor the Mayor to File an Application for a Grant to be Made by the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency for Seventy-Five (75) Percentum of the Eligible Cost of Construction of the Publicly Owned Treatment Works.

Resolution Requesting the Redevelopment Agency to Allocate One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from its Redevelopment Bonding Authority to include that Portion of the West End Bounded by Messer, Bridgham, Cranston and Westminster Streets.

Resolution Requesting the Providence Redevelopment Agency to develop that vacant and wasted land South of Ernest Street between the Providence River on the East and Route 95 on the West.

Resolution Requesting a Public Hearing be conducted by the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning, relative to the use of Community Development Funds, in accordance with petition filed with the City Clerk.

Petition to the City Council requesting a Public Hearing to be held immediately relative to "An Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Lower South Providence Area

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Redevelopment Project, as Amended."

Resolution endorsing Senate Bill 86-S 2224, relating to the District Court.

Resolution opposing House Bill 86-H 7210, relative to Historical Area Zoning.

Petition of Rene V. Dionne to Change the name of Buell Court to Larson Court.

Petition of Ryan, Elliott Management, Inc., to the City Council requesting the address of the building situated at 10 Dorrance Street be changed to One Westminster Square.

Petition of the C. J. Fox Company requesting 240 Fox Place be changed to 2 Cedar Street.

Chairwoman DiRuzzo informs the members that the several foregoing Ordinances, Resolutions and Petitions should be postponed indefinitely in Committee because they all have been pending in Committee for some time and they have not been acted upon due to lack of interest and that a majority of the items were sponsored by former council people. This was so moved by Councilman O'Connor and seconded by Councilman Dillon, that they be postponed indefinitely in Committee.
