CHAIRMAN HASSETT: Items one through eleven are all associated with the reconstruction of I-195 and we have actually talked about that exhaustively over the last two weeks. Perhaps we should hear from John Garrahy, who is the legal counsel from the Rhode Island Department of Transportation. I know there was one change John, was it Coletta?

JOHN J. GARRAHY: The Coletta one that is right, Mr. Chairman. Essentially, these are all the abandonments that are necessary for I-195. As you indicated the Coletta Realty one was not originally submitted by DOT but was submitted by Coletta Realty. DOT has now purchased the abutting property owned by Coletta Realty so we have essentially taken over that petition for abandonment and asks that it be included within the DOT petitions. The only thing that might be a little bit unusual with respect to this one is that some of them talk about subject to easements. All of the utilities that are in the roadway are going to be relocated at the expense of the State because there is a specific statute that authorizes that, so I

would just indicate that if there are any utilities the resolutions indicate that they be removed or relocated at the expense of the State, if necessary.

CHAIRMAN HASSETT: Okay.

JOHN J. GARRAHY: I don't have anything further to add unless there are any questions.

CHAIRMAN HASSETT: Any question of committee members? Okay, is there any objection of consolidating items one through eleven in one vote?

COUNCILWOMAN DI RUZZO: I have no objection.

CHAIRMAN HASSETT: Okay, is there a motion to approve items one through eleven.

On motion of Councilwoman DiRuzzo, Seconded by Councilman Segal, it is voted to approve the foregoing matters.

CHAIRMAN HASSETT: All those in favor.


COMMITTEE: Aye.
