OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF
PROVIDENCE, 1946, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRA-
TION."

Discussion ensues on this subject and it is the
consensus that since it would require two readings and
passages by the City Council and the fact that there remains
only one regular meeting of this City Council before it
adjourns sine die the Ordinance should be continued until
the succeeding 1967-1970 City Council.

On motion of Councilman Souza, seconded by Councilman
McNulty, it is voted to continue the matter to the 1967-
1970 City Council.

RELATIVE TO PETITIONS TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR
ABATEMENT AND/OR REASSESSMENT OF HURRICANE
BARRIER ASSESSMENT.

The Clerk submits the following petitions requesting
abatement and/or refund of the Hurricane Barrier Assessment:

Vice Chairman Lynch observes that these matters are
such that whatever action this Committee takes would set a
precedent and therefore feels a thorough investigation should
be undertaken at which time the City Solicitor and the City
Assessor should be invited to attend.

man Souza, it is voted to continue the above noted petitions
until the Committee on Finance decides to conduct a meeting
on these matters and to invite the Solicitor and Assessor
to attend.

RELATIVE TO RESOLUTION REFUNDING TO UNITED
TRANSIT COMPANY THE SUM OF THIRTY SIX DOLLARS
and 45/100 CENTS (\$36.45)
The Clerk Reports the amount of thirty six dollars

and forty five cents (\$36.45) represents an overpayment by the United Transit Company on October 14, 1966.

FOR LOTS IN NORTH BURIAL GROUND.
