The Committee on Finance meets this day in Committee Room "A" at 12:00 o'clock N. Present: Chairman Laudati and Councilmen Boyle, Loughran and Lazarus.

Also present are Finance Director Cashman, Budget Officer Moran and City Controller Keegan. (William E. McWilliams, Assistant Clerk).

Budget Officer Moran outlines the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1051 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$2500) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR WATER FUND TAXES, ITEM 3. (In City Council June 6, 1957. Read and Passed the first time.)

This Ordinance appropriates \$2500 to Water Fund-Taxes to pay increase in taxes on property owned by Water Department in Cranston and Foster. Charge to Water Surplus-Payment to Sinking Fund.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1051 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$25,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR WATER FUND-ADMINISTRATION, ITEM 5. (In City Council June 6, 1957. Read and Passed the first time.)

This Ordinance appropriates \$25,000 to Water Fund-Administration, to meet the cost of installing a radio communications system to replace the present mobile telephone service which has proven unsatisfactory because the service area is very limited. Charge to Water Surplus-Payment to Sinking Fund.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Boyle, it is voted to return the above Ordinances to City Council with recommendation of passage a second time.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 760, SECTION 1, "ESTABLISHING A CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE", AS APPROVED AUGUST 7, 1953. (In City Council May 2, 1957. Referred to Committee on Finance.)

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Boyle, it is voted to lay on the table indefinitely in Committee the above Ordinance and the following Ordinance is substituted.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 760, SECTION 1, "ESTABLISHING A CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE", AS APPROVED AUGUST 7, 1953.

This Ordinance as amended is further amended by revising the job specifications for the following classifications.

ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR I (748)

PLUMBING INSPECTOR I (428)
