In the absence of Chairman Mariani and Vice-Chairman Moakler, on motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, Mr. Laudati is elected Acting Chairman.

Finance Director Cashman outlines the following:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY (\$3,980) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR THE INSPECTOR OF BUILDINGS, ITEM 1. (In City Council September 4, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance transfers \$3,980.00 to Inspector of Buildings, Item 1, from Providence Redevelopment Agency, Item 1. This appropriation is to be used for paying for removal of a building on Canal Street.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED (\$2,900) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT DIVISION, ITEM 1. (In City Council September 4, 1952. Read and passed the first time)
This Ordinance transfers \$2,900 to Employees' Retirement

Division, Item 1. This money is to be transferred from the following sources:

City Controller's Division, Item 1	\$1200.00
City Controller's Division, Item 2	300.00
Employees' Retirement Division, Item 2	300.00
Tabulating Division, Item 1	500.00

These funds are to be used for paying Mr. Buck for services rendered.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND (\$3,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR ROGER WILLIAMS PARK, ITEM 1. (In City Council September 4, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance transfers \$3,000.00 to Roger Williams Park, Item 1, from Parks General. This appropriation is to pay part of the cost of sealcoating roads in Roger Williams Park.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWELVE THOUSAND (\$12,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR THE BOARD OF CANVASSERS, ITEM 0. (In City Council September 4, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance transfers \$12,000.00 to Board of Canvassers, Item 0, from the following departments:

Police Department, Item 0	\$4,000.00
Fire Department, Item 0	4,000.00
Bridge Maintenance Division, Item 7	4,000.00

This appropriation is to pay enumerators, clerical employees for balance of year and part of cost of primaries.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, 1946, AND ESTABLISHING A TRUST AND SPECIAL FUND FOR RECEIPTS FROM THE VALLEY VIEW VETERANS' RENTAL HOUSING DEVELOPMENT. (In City Council September 4, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance sets up a Trust and Special Fund to be held by the City Treasurer for the receipts, from the Valley View Veterans' Rental Housing Development, in excess of the current needs for the retirement of debt incurred in connection with the Valley View Veterans' Rental Housing Development.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is voted to return the above Ordinances to the City Council with recommendation of passage a second time.
