AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 299, BY ADDING THE SUM OF \$1,000.00 TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR PUBLIC CELEBRATIONS-MUNICIPAL CHRISTMAS TREE.

(This additional appropriation is necessary to carry out the Celebration being conducted by the Special City Council Committee and the Retail Merchants.)

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 40, CHAPTER 2, REVISED ORDINANCES OF 1946, ENTITLED, "REFUND OF COLLECTIONS ACCOUNT".

(The Ordinance is amended to provide that refunds at the Charles V. Chapin Hospital may be made from an imprest fund which will be established for that purpose. Previously patients at the Charles V. Chapin Hospital paid in advance and if they left the Hospital before the time for which they had paid in advance, it was a cumbersome procedure for the person to obtain the refund. This Ordinance simplifies the procedure by establishing a fund at the Hospital from which immediate refunds can be made.)
