

RE \$2,000,000.00 "UNEMPLOYMENT RELIEF LOAN" - CIRCULAR.

On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Testa, it is voted to authorize City Treasurer Walter F. Fitzpatrick to proceed with the preparation and mailing of a circular dated, March 5, 1943, of proposal for the \$2,000,000.00 loan; said circular setting forth pertinent information relative to said loan with invitations for proposals addressed to Walter F. Fitzpatrick, City Treasurer, Providence, Rhode Island, each endorsed "Proposal for Loan" will be received at the City Treasurer's Office until 2:00 o'clock P.M., E.W.T. Tuesday, March 16, 1943 for the whole of the issue, and it is further voted, on motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Testa, that the City Treasurer be authorized to advertise the sale of these bonds in the "Daily Bond Buyer".
