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1. Petition From Henry Rosciti, Sr., P.O. Box 19120, Johnston, Rhode Island 02919, requesting the abandonment of Celia Street which runs from Grimmwood Avenue to the Johnston line at Maria Avenue.
2. Resolution Requesting to Reconsider Resolution No. 189, Approved May 4, 2005, relative to the abandonment of Swift Street.
3. Resolution Requesting the abandonment of certain lots located at the intersection of Niagara Street, Early Street, Cadillac Drive and Rodman Street, located in the Elmwood Neighborhood, be merged with abutting property located at 38 Rodman Street (Plat 53, Lot 480), and transferred to the Parks Department for use as a permanent community garden.
4. Resolution Authorizing the city to cause the release of the Fill and Side Slope easement for property adjacent to Ianthe Street near its intersection with Branch Avenue, granted by Providence Worcester Railroad Company, the Old Colony Railroad Company, the Boston and Providence Railroad Company, and the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company, to the city for the sum of one dollar (\$1.00), in accordance with specific provisions of said resolution.
5. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Old Road to be designated as a "One-Way" Street from Mount Pleasant Avenue to Smith Street.
6. Resolution Requesting the Department of Transportation to cause Smithfield Avenue to be established as a "Two-Way" Street in its entirety.
7. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to designate that area located along Pleasant Valley Parkway from Garfield Avenue to Oakland Avenue as a "No Parking Zone", on both sides.
8. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "No Parking" Signs on the southerly side of Roosevelt Street near its intersection with Bancroft Street.
9. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Stop" Signs on the corner of Wild Street and Andy Street.
10. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Stop" Signs on the corner of Andy Street and Wild Street.
11. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "No Parking Anytime" Signs on the corner of Charles Street and Ledge Street.
12. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "No Parking Anytime" Signs on the corner of Charles Street and Jasper Street.

13. Resolution Requesting the Department of Public Property to cause the removal of graffiti along various locations in the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward.
