3. An Ordinance Amending a Compensation Plan for the Providence School Department and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2009-32, No. 236, Approved May 29, 2009.
4. An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Employees in certain Classes in the Providence School Department and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2009-30, No.234, Approved May 29, 2009
5. Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the School Board of the City of Providence and the Providence Teachers Union Local 958 AFL-CIO for the period effective September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2010.
