2. An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 336 of Chapter 2019-83, Adopted July 9, 2019 providing for the Assessment and Collection of 2019 Taxes in a sum not less than Three Hundred Fifty One Million Eight Hundred Twenty Six Thousand and Six Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$351,826,648) and not more than Three Hundred Fifty Seven Million Nine Hundred Eighty Four Thousand and Five Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$357,984,559) being based on a One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year Tax Collections, and setting the rates for Fiscal Year 2021.

3. An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 2019-84, No. 337, Approved July 9, 2019 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, making an Appropriation of Seven Hundred Seventy Million, One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand, Four Hundred Ninety-Four Dollars and no cents (\$770,169,494.00) for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2020, As Amended.

4. An Ordinance Establishing A Compensation Plan for the City of Providence and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2019-110, No. 338, Approved November 26, 2019, As Amended.

5. An Ordinance Establishing the Classes of Positions, the Maximum Number of Employees and the Number of Employees in Certain Classes in the City Departments and Repealing Ordinance Chapter 2019-111, No. 497, Approved November 26, 2019, As Amended.

During the Budget Deliberations, the Committee may seek to enter into Executive Session pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws Section 42-46-5 (a) (2) specific to potential litigation related to Public Works contracts, with vendors that may include, but are not limited to those providing scooters, Jump Bikes and other transportation.
