3 Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning will
4 come to order. We have two items on the agenda
5 for tonight. This is a public hearing, so
6 anybody here wishing to sign in, please do so,
7 right in front.

8 This is only going to be to hear comments.
9 This is not for questions and answers. If
10 anybody would like to speak on any of the items
11 who is present here, please do so.

12 MR. CLEMENT: There are sign-in
13 sheets on each item on the agenda this evening.
14 If you would like to be heard on either matter,
15 you can sign in either for or against whichever
16 item that you wish to speak on, and that's if you
17 would like to be heard.

18 The first item on the agenda, which is
19 scheduled for 6 p.m., is an ordinance in
20 amendment of and in addition to Chapter 1986-53
21 of the ordinance of the City of Providence
22 approved October 23, 1986 and entitled, "An
23 Ordinance Approving and Adopting the Official
24 Redevelopment Plan for the Special Vacant Lot

1 Project" for the acquisition of Lots 908, 910,
2 911 and 795 on Plat 48, 814, 808, 804 Broad
3 Street and 48-50 Norwich Street, respectively.
4 This was in city council on June 5, 2003 and was
5 responded by Councilman Aponte and Councilman
6 Hassett.

7 If anybody wishes to speak on this item, they
