DISCUSSION RELATIVE TO:

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO CHAPTER 1983-19 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED MAY 3, 1983 AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE TRINITY GATEWAY REVITALIZATION PROJECT" FOR ADDITIONAL PARCEL CONTROLS.


Mr. Deller informs the members that this amendment allows for a piece of property to be acquired from State Department of Transportation. He states that the property is located in a National Historic District and the State Historic Preservation Office usually requires that a detailed plan be submitted and approved by them prior to authorization to sell property in that District. Further, the Redevelopment Agency has no specific plans at this time, and the State Historic Preservation Office has agreed to allow the sale to go through from the RI DOT to the Redevelopment Agency on the condition that any plans for the future use of this property be approved by the local Historic District Commission and that is the basis of the language amendment.

Accordingly, on motion of Vice-Chairwoman Young, seconded by Councilwoman Nolan, it is voted that the foregoing Ordinance be transmitted to the City Council with recommendation of approval.
