MASHAPAUG POND REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 4 and 11 of Chapter 32, Title 45 of the general laws of Rhode Island 1956 as amended (1970 Reenactment entitled the "Redevelopment Act of 1956", the Committee on Urban Redevelopment, Renewal and Planning of the City of Providence will conduct a public hearing in the Chamber of the City Council, City Hall, Providence, R.I. on February 17, 1988 starting at 7:00 P.M.

This hearing will be concerned with the amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Mashapaug Pond Redevelopment Project as proposed by the Providence Redevelopment Agency in a report titled Mashapaug Pond Redevelopment Project approved December 2, 1960 and will permit the Subdivision of certain parcels of land, which contain five (5) acres or more for multiple occupancy.

The project area is within the southwestern section of the City of Providence and is generally bounded by Huntington Avenue on the north, Mashapaug Pond on the east, Access Road on the south and Niantic Avenue on the west.

All persons or agencies interested in the above listed project will have an opportunity to be heard and/or to submit communication in writing. Copies of the proposed amendment to the Redevelopment Plans and information thereon may be obtained prior to said hearing at the Providence Redevelopment Agency, 44 Washington Street, Providence, Rhode Island between 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. on regular business days.
