**APPLICATION OF SHELL OIL PRODUCTS COMPANY, 152-162  
ANGELL STREET.**

islands and relocate two of the existing dispensers and add two multi-product

to clear things up we have a large number of hoses but it is going to eight fueling

hopefully keep cars from piling up out on the street.
