REQUEST OF LUCILLE A. LOGA, AN EMPLOYEE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INSPECTION AND STANDARDS, FOR A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM OCTOBER 3, 1988 TO APRIL 3, 1989, FOR MATERNITY LEAVE.

On motion of Councilman O'Connor, seconded by Councilman Dillon, it is voted to approve the request of Lucille A. Loga for a leave of absence from October 3, 1988 to April 3, 1989, for maternity reasons.

REQUEST OF LOUIS SALINARO, AN EMPLOYEE OF THE WATER SUPPLY BOARD, REQUESTING A LEAVE OF ABSENCE FROM SEPTEMBER 6, 1988 TO JANUARY 27, 1989, AS HE HAS BEEN SELECTED FOR THE POLICE ACADEMY FOR THE PROVIDENCE POLICE DEPARTMENT.

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 51 OF CHAPTER 1988-22, APPROVED JULY 1, 1988, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1987-30, APPROVED OCTOBER 20, 1987, AS AMENDED," RELATIVE TO REHABILITATION SPECIALIST/PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT.

Councilman Dillon states an error was submitted at budget time to the position of Fire Equipment Superintendent II as the persons figuring out the Union increases used the wrong figures from what the position was paid previously. It is therefore correcting an administrative error.

On motion of Councilman Glavin, seconded by Councilman Dillon, it is voted to approve the foregoing Ordinance and transmit same to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption.
