AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF AND IN ADDITION TO ARTICLE VI OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, ENTITLED: "TAX ABATEMENT ON REHABILITATED PROPERTY," BY ADDING SEC. 21-136.

Chairwoman Brassil informs the members the foregoing matter was referred to Vincent Pallozzi, Mayor's Chief of Staff, in accordance with his request, as he had stated he would review the Ordinance, together with suggested amendments submitted by the City Collector and transmit a copy of a final draft to the Committee.

As the same has not been submitted, she recommends the matter be continued.

On motion of Councilman Dillon, seconded by Councilman Farmer, the foregoing Ordinance is continued.

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1986-32, APPROVED JUNE 26, 1986, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE", RELATIVE TO THE PARKS ZOOLOGICAL AND SECURITY SERVICE.

Chairwoman Brassil explains the above Ordinance is submitted to correct an error in the typing of the Compensation Ordinance. The person involved did not receive the percentage increase along with other City employees and the Ordinance would correct that error, retroactive to July 1, 1986.

On motion of Councilman Farmer, seconded by Councilman Dillon, it is voted to approve the foregoing Ordinance and transmit same to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption.

AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2-22 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, ENTITLED "SALARY OF MAYOR" AND SECTION 2-23, ENTITLED, "SALARIES OF COUNCILMEN, EXPENSE ACCOUNTS."

On motion of Councilman Dillon, seconded by Councilman Farmer, it is voted to approve the foregoing Ordinance and transmit same to the City Council with recommendation of Passage a Second Time, subject to a Public Hearing being scheduled and held prior to submission to the City Council.

REQUEST FOR LEAVE OF ABSENCE - ELIZABETH B. BRYANT,  
DEPARTMENT OF COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Chairwoman Brassil reads the request for a Leave of Absence Without Pay for Elizabeth B. Bryant, employed as an Administrative Assistant to the Commissioner of Public Safety, from November 10, 1986 to November 10, 1987 due to complications of her pregnancy.

A communication from Commissioner Pisaturo recommends the Leave be granted.

On motion of Councilman Dillon, seconded by Councilman Farmer, it is voted to approve the request of Elizabeth B. Bryant for a Leave of Absence from November 10, 1986 to November 10, 1987.

COMMUNICATION FROM CITY COLLECTOR RONALD L. TARRO  
RELATIVE TO HURRICANE BARRIER TAX.

Chairwoman Brassil reads a communication from Mr. Tarro dated October 31, 1986, recommending the Hurricane Barrier tax be removed from 133 Mathewson Street for the Community Resources Center for the Elderly, Inc., a tax-exempt elderly non-profit association, in the amount of \$1,800, and further recommending a reimbursement of \$1,200.00 to the Center.

Chairwoman Brassil informs the members she had requested Mr. Tarro look into this matter and submit his opinion to the Committee.

On motion of Councilman Farmer, seconded by Councilman Dillon, the Clerk is requested to draft the appropriate Resolution relative to the above and transmit same to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption.
