The Committee on Finance meets this day in the Conference Room, City Hall, at 3:00 o'clock P.M.

Present: Chairman Lynch and Councilmen McKiernan, Garan, Councilwoman Brassil, Councilmen Crowley, Stravato and Bradshaw.

Also present is Finance Director Vincent T. Izzo.

Chairman Lynch states the decision for the amount of the Appropriation Ordinance change is from \$94,815,119.09 to \$93,804,112.00.

On motion of Councilman McKiernan, seconded by Councilman Stravato, it is voted to recommend back to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption, the following Ordinance, as amended.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATION OF \$93,804,112.00 FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1976.

Councilman Bradshaw desires to be recorded as voting "No".

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1974-55, APPROVED DECEMBER 20, 1974.

On motion of Councilman McKiernan, seconded by Councilman Crowley, it is voted to refer the above Ordinance back to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption, as amended.

Councilman Bradshaw desires to be recorded as voting "no".

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND REPEALING CHAPTER 1974-54, APPROVED DECEMBER 20, 1974.

On motion of Councilman McKiernan, seconded by Councilman Stravato, it is voted to refer the above Ordinance back to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption, as amended.

Councilman Bradshaw desires to be recorded as voting "No".

RELATIVE TO AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF 1975 TAXES.

Chairman Lynch requests Mr. Izzo determine an amount to coincide with the foregoing Ordinances in place of the figure \$57,436,180.00; the \$47,902,776.00 amount can remain the same.

Mr. Izzo, after careful study, states the amount would be \$53,327,012.00.

Chairman Lynch suggests the figure be \$53,000,000.00.

On motion of Councilman Garan, seconded by Councilman McKiernan, it is voted to recommend to the City Council with recommendation of Adoption, the following Ordinance, as amended.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION OF 1975 TAXES IN A SUM NOT LESS THAN FORTY SEVEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY SIX (\$47,902,776) DOLLARS, NOR MORE THAN FIFTY THREE MILLION (\$53,000,000.00) DOLLARS.

COUNCILMAN Bradshaw desires to be recorded as voting "No".

RELATIVE TO POSITIONS UNDER THE CETA PROGRAM.

Councilman McKiernan states the Mayor has been advertising in the newspaper for the filling of staff positions in the new program under the CETA program. He is of the opinion, the City Council has not been in receipt of any Ordinance setting up such a department classifying such positions.

Chairman Lynch agrees.

On motion of Councilman McKiernan, seconded by Councilmen Crowley and Stravato, it is voted that a communication be sent to the Department of Housing and Urban Development in Boston enclosing the City Council Resolution which authorized the Mayor to apply under the CETA Grant, calling their attention to the fact this Committee feels the Mayor is now in violation of that Resolution as he has not gone through the City Council pursuant to the terms of the Resolution.

It is further voted that copies of this communication be sent to Senator Pastore, Senator Pell, Congressman Beard and Congressman St. Germain.

An opinion is further requested of the City Solicitor as to taking of speedy action on the matter.

Councilman Bradshaw desires to be recorded as voting "No".
