AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENT, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 70-28, APPROVED JUNE 23, 1970.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND REPEALING CHAPTER 70-27, APPROVED JUNE 23, 1970.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES AND COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO THE SEVERAL CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES HEREIN NAMED, AND REPEALING CHAPTER 70-29, APPROVED JUNE 23, 1970.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 760, SECTION 1, "ESTABLISHING THE CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE," AS APPROVED AUGUST 7, 1953.
