AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF CHAPTER 69-35 "ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS," AS APPROVED SEPTEMBER 22, 1969, RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 69-33, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED (3,600) DOLLARS TO THE BOARD OF TENANT'S AFFAIRS.

On motion of Councilman McNulty, seconded by Councilman Bradshaw, it is voted to transmit the above Ordinances to the City Council with recommendation for Adoption.

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO INVESTIGATE THE ASSESSMENT PRACTICE OF THE CITY OF NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASCERTAINING WHETHER THE SAME METHOD OF ASSESSMENT CAN BE INSTALLED IN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

On motion of Councilman McNulty, seconded by Councilman Bradshaw, it is voted to Receive the above Resolution and to send it back to the City Council and refer it to the Committee on Tax Exemption.
