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The Committee on Finance meets this day in Committee Room "A" at 11:00 o'clock a.m. Present: Councilmen O'Connor, Loughran and Lazarus.

Also present are Finance Director Cashman, City Controller Keegan and Budget Officer Moran. (W. E. McWilliams, Assistant Clerk.)

VICE-CHAIRMAN O'CONNOR IN THE CHAIR

Budget Officer Moran outlines the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION AND TRAFFIC CONTROL IN THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$400,000.00) DOLLARS. (In City Council November 17, 1955. Read and Passed the first time.)

This Ordinance provides for the issuance of \$400,000.00 of Traffic Signal Installation and Traffic Control Bonds.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR A PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE AND A MUNICIPAL GARAGE AND WAREHOUSE IN THE SUM OF EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$800,000.00) DOLLARS. (In City Council November 17, 1955. Read and Passed the first time.)

This Ordinance provides for the issuance of \$800,000 of Public Works Garage, Municipal Garage and Warehouse Bonds.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR THE PAYMENT OF OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY INCURRED FOR THE RELIEF OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND THE PRESERVATION OF MUNICIPAL PROPERTY IN THE EMERGENCY CAUSED BY THE HURRICANE OF AUGUST 31, 1954. (In City Council November 17, 1955. Read and Passed the first time.)

This Ordinance provides for the issuance of \$1,000,000 of Hurricane Bonds.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is voted to return the above Ordinances to the City Council with recommendation of passage a second time.

BUREAU OF AUDITS REPORT ON EXAMINATION OF ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 1954.

After a discussion it is agreed that the report should be presented to the City Council.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is voted that the Report and Examination of Accounts for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1954 from the State Bureau of Audits be presented to the City Council.

Finance Director Cashman reads the following communication from Joseph Smith, M.D., Superintendent of Health, dated November 15, 1955, which states:

"Mr. Thomas W. Donnelly, one of our Sanitarian Aides II has asked for temporary leave of absence to pursue some full time courses at Northeastern University in Boston.

Mr. Donnelly will study some courses in which will be of indirect value to this department.

An attempt was made to have his courses authorized thru the Federal Public Health Program, however, inasmuch as these courses were to be given at Northeastern University, these funds were not available. Funds are available only if the individual goes to a School of Public Health."
