AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 151 AND 152 OF CHAPTER 2
OF THE 1946 REVISED ORDINANCES BY INCREASING COMPENSATION
OF PRIMARY AND ELECTION OFFICIALS. (In City Council May
15, 1952. Referred to Committee on Finance)

The above Ordinance is to increase the salary of Election
Officials from the present Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per day
to Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars per day.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is
voted to present the above Ordinance to the City Council with
recommendation of passage the first time.

Budget Officer Moran outlines the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER
533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY-NINE HUNDRED (\$2900)
DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR PARKS
GENERAL, ITEM 1. (In City Council May 15, 1952. Read
and passed the first time)

This Ordinance adds \$2900.00 to Parks General, Item 1 for
repairing sidewalks on approaches to railroad station.

This money is obtained from increased receipts from Reserve
for Extraordinary Expenditures.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER
533, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00)
DOLLARS TO AMERICAN VETERANS, WORLD WAR II, DEPARTMENT
CONVENTION, ITEM 3. (In City Council May 15, 1952. Read
and passed the first time)

This Ordinance appropriates \$500.00 to American Veterans,
World War II, Department Convention to be held in Providence,
June 6th, 7th and 8th.

This appropriation is to be charged to General Fund from
Funds Not Otherwise Appropriated.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER
533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY (\$460.00)
DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR POLICE
COURT, ITEMS 0 AND 1. (In City Council May 15, 1952.
Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance transfers \$460.00 from City Collector's

Division to Police Court. \$210.00 is added to Item 0 to make up a shortage in the budget appropriation. \$250.00 is added to Item 1 to meet increased printing costs due to an increase in number of tags issued.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE (\$395.00) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR SANITARY ENGINEER DIVISION, ITEMS 0, 1 AND 2. (In City Council May 15, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance transfers \$395.00 from City Collector's Division to Sanitary Engineer. \$170.00 is added to Item 0 due to insufficient funds being appropriated in budget and \$225.00 is added to Items 1 and 2 for automobile repairs, gasoline and office supplies.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR ROGER WILLIAMS Park, Item 1. (In City Council May 15, 1952. Read and passed the first time)

This Ordinance adds \$1,000.00 to Roger Williams Park, Item 1 to pay for band concerts to be given at Roger Williams Park this summer. This appropriation is to be charged to funds not otherwise appropriated.


On motion of Mr. Moakler, seconded by Mr. Loughran, it is voted to present the foregoing Ordinances to the City Council with recommendation of passage the second time.
