The Committee on Finance meets this day at 12:00 o'clock M.

Present: Chairman Mariani and Messrs. Laudati and Lazarus. Budget Officer Moran and Assistant City Controller Hartigan are also present. (James J. Kelly, Assistant Clerk)

Budget Officer Moran outlines the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF THIRTEEN HUNDRED (\$1,300) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR INTEREST ON FLOATING DEBT, ITEM 3. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Thirteen Hundred (\$1300.00) Dollars is appropriated from Interest on Floating Debt, Item 3, because of the increased interest rate on notes renewed by the various banks. The money is obtained from Increased Revenue from General Departments-Interest.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY (\$1,750) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR PARKS GENERAL, ITEM 0. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

To pay the increased cost of the summer payroll for Parks, the sum of \$1,750.00 is transferred from Parks General, Item 5 to Parks General, Item 0.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR RECORDER OF DEEDS, ITEMS 1 AND 2. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Six Hundred and Fifty (\$650.00) Dollars is appropriated to Recorder of Deeds, Item I for Book Binding and Postal Supplies to take care of the backlog of postwar work and Thirteen Hundred and Fifty (\$1350.00) Dollars is appropriated to meet the increased cost of chemical and photostat paper. The money is obtained from increased property taxes in the current year.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR DEXTER ASYLUM, ITEM 0. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000) Dollars is transferred from Dexter Asylum, Item II to Dexter Asylum, Item 0, to cover the cost of increased working hours of three Stationary Firemen from thirty-

eight hours to fifty-six hours per week.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF SIXTY (\$60) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR BUILDING ORDINANCE BOARD OF REVIEW, ITEM 1. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

To cover the increased amount of advertising and postage due to the large number of public hearings, the sum of Sixty (\$60) Dollars is appropriated to Building Ordinance Board of Review, Item I. The money is obtained from Increased Property Taxes-Current Year.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF SEVENTY (\$70) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR ZONING BOARD OF REVIEW, ITEM 1. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Seventy (\$70) Dollars is appropriated to Zoning Board of Review, Item I, for the same reason as outlined in the previous Ordinance. The money is obtained from Increased Taxes-Current Year.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 129, SECTION 47 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AS APPROVED SEPTEMBER 3, 1948. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

This amends Chapter 129, Section 47, Chapin Hospital, by deleting one Chemist II and adds one Chemist I. The Superintendent of the Hospital, Dr. Connor, has requested this change as he does not need the higher classification and the change will put both chemists on an equal basis.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY DECREASING THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF RECREATION BY THE SUM OF FOURTEEN THOUSAND (\$14,000) DOLLARS, ITEMS 0, 1 AND 2. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

This is a reduction of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000) Dollars in the appropriation for Department of Recreation, Items 0, 1 and 2, and is the amount expected to be saved by the delay in opening of the Swimming Pools.


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 128, BY ADDING THE SUM OF EIGHT THOUSAND (\$8,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR STREET CLEANING, ITEMS 1 AND 2. (In City Council July 7, 1949. Read and passed the first time)

\$2,000.00 is transferred from Street Cleaning, Item 0 to Item I, Street Cleaning and \$6,000.00 from Street Cleaning, Item 0 to Street Cleaning, Item II. Item I is to be used for broom refills for sweepers and Item II is for repair parts for sweepers and wire for refilling of gutter brooms on sweepers.

On motion of Mr. Laudati, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is voted to return the nine foregoing Ordinances to the City Council with recommendation of passage a second time.
