The Committee on Finance meets this day at 12:00 o'clock Noon. Present: Chairman Mariani and Messrs. Laudati and Lord.

Budget Director Reynolds, City Solicitor McCabe and City Controller Keegan are also present. (James J. Kelly, Assistant Clerk)

At the request of Chairman Mariani, Budget Director Reynolds explains the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 1513 OF 1946, BY ADDING THE SUM OF ELEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED (\$11,200) DOLLARS TO FIRE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 2. (In City Council January 16, 1947. Read and passed the first time and referred to Committee on Finance.)

This Ordinance is for the purchase of steel wheels and rims and new tires for 14 pieces of apparatus for the Fire Department. The wheels and rims will cost approximately \$4,000.00 and the new tires about \$7,000.00.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 1513 OF 1946, BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE (\$9,755) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC SERVICE ENGINEER DEPARTMENT, DIVISION OF AIR POLLUTION, ITEMS 0, 1 AND 2. (In City Council January 16, 1947. Read and passed the first time and referred to Committee on Finance.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1209, ESTABLISHING A CLASSIFICATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE. (In City Council January 16, 1947. Read and passed the first time and referred to Committee on Finance.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1510 ESTABLISHING A COMPENSATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, AS APPROVED SEPTEMBER 6, 1946. (In City Council January 16, 1947. Read and passed the first time and referred to Committee on Finance.)

These three Ordinances concern the setting up of the Division of Air Pollution in the Public Service Engineer's Department. The sum of \$7,755.00 is allocated to Item "0" for the remainder of the fiscal year to provide for the wages of the Chief Air Pollution Regulation Engineer whose salary will be \$3,800.00-\$4,500.00 per year and three Air Pollution Inspectors whose salaries will be \$2,496.00 per year. \$1,000.00 is allocated for Item "1" and \$1,000.00 for Item "2". These two items are not broken down as yet as the Division is new and they have no way of ascertaining just what the expenses will be.

The Ordinance amending Chapter 1209 establishes a Classification Plan covering the Chief Air Pollution Regulation Engineer and the Air Pollution Inspectors.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1509 SECTIONS 4, 14 AND 29 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AS APPROVED SEPTEMBER 6, 1946 AND ADDING SECTION 29-A THERETO. (In City Council January 16, 1947. Read and passed the first time and referred to Committee on Finance.)

This Ordinance adds one Clerk-Typist I to the Police Court making two in all which is necessary because of the increase in handling of traffic violations, and also adds one Clerk III to the City Collector's Division, making six in all. This Clerk will be the supervisor of the IBM equipment.

In the Public Service Engineer's Department, Air Pollution Division, is added one Chief Air Pollution Regulation Engineer and three Air Pollution Inspectors and one Deputy Smoke Inspector is eliminated.

On motion of Mr. Lord, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return the five foregoing Ordinances to the City Council at its next meeting with recommendation of passage a second time.


