The Committee on Finance meets this day at 12:00 o'clock Noon. Present: Chairman Presel and Messrs. Mariani, Munroe, and Testa. Absent: Mr. Coppen. (W. Earl Dodd, Clerk).

RE SUPERVISOR OF INVENTORY AND WAREHOUSES. Chairman Presel states that Budget Director Reynolds requested him to call a meeting of the Finance Committee to consider authorization of a salary of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for a Supervisor of Inventory and Warehouses in the Purchasing Agent's Department.

Mr. Presel states that he is opposed to granting this authorization because he is of the opinion that the Committee would be doing an illegal thing and further that the amount of purchases by the City during the past two years does not warrant the hiring of a Supervisor of Inventory and Warehouses at the present time.

On motion of Mr. Mariani, seconded by Mr. Testa, the following vote is adopted:

VOTED: That the Committee on Finance be and it hereby authorizes the Purchasing Agent to employ a Supervisor of Inventory and Warehouses at a salary not to exceed \$4,000.00 per year; said salary to be effective June 14, 1943.

Mr. Presel desires to be recorded as voting "No" on this matter.
