- 1. Communication from His Honor the Mayor dated January 11, 2019, Informing the Honorable Members of the City Council that pursuant to Section 302(b) of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, as amended, Section 8-13 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence, and Public Law, Chapter 45-50 Sections 1 through 31 passed in 1987, he is this day re-appointing David Igliazzi, Esquire of 1351 Pippin Orchard Road, Cranston, Rhode Island 02921, as an Associate Justice of the Providence Housing Court, for a term to expire on December 31, 2019, and respectfully submits the same for your approval.**

MR. IGLIOZZI: Presently, I'm at 1351 Pippin Orchard Road, in Cranston, Rhode Island.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: So, we have it at – do we have a difference in the address?

FIRST DEPUTY CITY CLERK MASTROIANNI: We do.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: So, the letter from the Mayor has a different address. Is that correct?

MR. IGLIOZZI: The house was just sold, Madame Chair.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: Do we need to amend the letter?

FIRST DEPUTY CITY CLERK MASTROIANNI: We do.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: Okay. So, may I have a motion to amend the letter dated January 11th to the Honorable Members of the City Council from Mayor Jorge O. Elorza to change the address, striking 20 Legion Memorial Drive and replacing it with –

FIRST DEPUTY CITY CLERK MASTROIANNI: 1351 Pippin Orchard Road, Cranston, Rhode Island – what is the zip there?

MR. IGLIOZZI: 02921.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: May I have a motion.

COUNCILMAN TAYLOR: I make the motion that we change it to 1351 Pippin Orchard Road, Cranston, Rhode Island.

COUNCILWOMAN CASTILLO: Second.

On motion of Councilman Taylor, Seconded by Councilwoman Castillo, it is voted to amend the letter dated January 11th to the Honorable Members of the City Council from Mayor Jorge O. Elorza by changing the address to 1351 Pippin Orchard Road, Cranston, Rhode Island, 02921.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: All in favor.

COMMITTEE: Ayes.

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN RYAN: All opposed. The “Ayes” have it. Do we need to change the agenda? The address needs to be restated there?
