
July 2, 1951.

Pursuant to a call for a meeting at 12:00 Noon this day, Chairman Mariani is the only member in attendance. Lacking a quorum Chairman Mariani directs the Clerk to poll the Committee relative to the following:

The following Ordinances were in City Council June 7, 1951. Read and passed the first time.

- 1- An Ordinance amending Chapter 423, Section 4 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 22, 1950.
- 2- An Ordinance amending the Appropriation Ordinance, Chapter 422, by appropriating the sum of Eight Hundred Forty-Two (\$842.00) Dollars to the Appropriation contained therein for Police Court, Item 0.
- 3- An Ordinance amending Chapter 422 by appropriating the sum of Thirty-Seven Thousand (\$37,000) Dollars to Chapin Hospital, Items 1 and 2.
- 4- An Ordinance amending the Appropriation Ordinance, Chapter 422 by adding the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars to the Appropriation contained therein for Public Works Department - Construction and Maintenance Division - Bridge Maintenance Section, Item 1.
- 5- An Ordinance amending Chapter 422 by adding the sum of Thirty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Forty (\$33,940) Dollars to the Appropriation contained therein for contributions to Employees' Retirement System.
- 6- An Ordinance amending Chapter 422 by adding the sum of Seven Thousand (\$7,000) Dollars to the Appropriation contained therein for Traffic Engineering Department, Item 2.

The Clerk records the vote on the six Ordinances enumerated above as follows: "Ayes" Chairman Mariani and Messrs. Moakler, Loughran and Lazarus. The Clerk is unable to contact Mr. Laudati.
