RE AUTHORIZING CITY TREASURER TO BORROW \$400,000.00 FOR UNEMPLOYMENT RELIEF. City Auditor Flynn explains that an appropriation is necessary for the purpose of paying for materials, supplies, supervision, transportation, and all other necessary expenses on purchases carried on under the Works Progress Administration. Mr. Flynn states that an amount of \$400,000.00 should be authorized, and of this amount \$200,000.00 is already spent.

On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted to recommend to the City Council, this day, passage of a resolution authorizing and directing the City Treasurer to borrow \$400,000.00 for the purpose of Unemployment Relief.
