RE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
SEPTEMBER 30, 1942. On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr.  
Mariani, it is voted to present to the City Council, an Ordinance  
making Appropriation of \$17,903,175.17 for the Support of the  
City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1942.

RE ORDINANCE INCREASING CITY TREASURER'S SALARY. On motion  
of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted to present  
to the City Council, an Ordinance in amendment of Section #1 of  
Chapter 55 of the Revised Ordinances of 1914 increasing the City  
Treasurer's Salary from \$5,200.00 to \$6,000.00 per annum; said  
Ordinance to take effect October 1, 1941.

RE ORDINANCE INCREASING SALARY OF THE INSPECTOR OF BUILD-  
INGS. On motion of Mr. Mariani, seconded by Mr. Munroe, it is  
voted to present an Ordinance to the City Council increasing  
the salary of the Inspector of Buildings from \$4,500.00 per annum  
to \$5,000.00 per annum.

RE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CLASS "B" CLERK IN TAX ASSESSORS'  
OFFICE. On motion of Mr. Mariani, seconded by Mr. Munroe, it is  
voted to present an Ordinance in amendment of Section 2 of Chapter  
55 of the Revised Ordinances of 1914 providing for a Class "B"  
Clerk in substitution for a Class "D" clerk in the Office of the  
Assessors of Taxes.

RE ORDINANCE INCREASING SALARY OF DEPUTY RECORDER OF DEEDS.  
On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted  
to present an Ordinance to the City Council amending Section 1  
of Chapter 55 of the Revised Ordinances of 1914 fixing the com-  
pensation of the Deputy Recorder of Deeds at \$50.00 per week; said  
salary to be effective October 1, 1941.

RESOLUTION ORDERING COLLECTION OF 1941 POLL TAXES. On  
motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted to  
present a Resolution ordering the collection of Poll Taxes by

the City Treasurer on and between the 15th day of December 1941 and January 5, 1942 inclusive.

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FOR THE BUREAU OF POLICE AND FIRE. On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted to present to the City Council an Ordinance providing for a transfer of funds to complete the present fiscal year for the Bureau of Police and Fire by transferring from the Fire Pension Account to Police Pension Account, the sum of \$5,000.00.


ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FOR CHAPIN HOSPITAL.

On motion of Mr. Munroe, seconded by Mr. Mariani, it is voted to present an Ordinance to the City Council increasing the appropriation for Charles V. Chapin Hospital in the sum of \$10,000.00 of which amount the sum of \$1,000.00 is to be added to Item 1, Salaries and the sum of \$9,000.00 is to be added to Item 2, Expenses; said appropriation being an addition for the present fiscal year ending September 30, 1941 and said sum of \$10,000.00 appropriated shall be charged to funds not otherwise appropriated.

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,500.00 FOR TAX DEPARTMENT.

On motion of Mr. Mariani, seconded by Mr. Munroe, it is voted to present an Ordinance appropriating an additional sum of \$5,500.00 to the appropriation for the Tax Department for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1941 of which the amount of \$4,000.00 is to be added to Item 1, Salaries and the sum of \$1,500.00 is to be added to Item 2, Expenses; said sum of \$5,500.00 appropriated shall be charged to funds not otherwise appropriated.
