Present: Messrs. Laudati, Loughran and Lazarus. Budget Officer Moran and City Controller Keegan are also present. (James J. Kelly, Assistant Clerk)

The Clerk advises that Chairman Mariani will be unable to attend and nominations are in order for Acting Chairman of this Committee.

Mr. Loughran nominates Mr. Laudati and this nomination is seconded by Mr. Lazarus. There being no counter nominations, the Clerk is directed to cast one ballot for Mr. Laudati as Acting Chairman of this Committee.

The Chair places the motion before the body and Acting Chairman Laudati and Mr. Loughran vote "Aye" and Mr. Lazarus is recorded as voting "No".

7 - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF SALARY FOR ALL CITY EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN MEMBERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND THE SCHOOL SYSTEM. (In City Council March 1, 1951. Referred to Committee on Finance)

8 - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF SALARY FOR ALL MEMBERS OF THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS. (In City Council March 1, 1951. Referred to Committee on Finance)

10 - RESOLUTION REQUESTING PURCHASE OF LAND FOR PLAYGROUND FOR CHILDREN OF SACKETT STREET AND LEXINGTON AVENUE SCHOOLS. (In City Council March 1, 1951. Referred to Committee on Finance)

Mr. Loughran moves that the Ordinances enumerated as 7, 8, 9, 10, be laid on the table. This motion is seconded by Acting Chairman Laudati.

The Chair puts the question before the body and Acting Chairman Laudati and Mr. Loughran vote "Aye". Mr. Lazarus votes "No".

Mr. Loughran presents six Ordinances in substitution of the previous six Ordinances indefinitely postponed by this Committee.

Mr. Lazarus requests that these six Ordinances be taken up individually and the Chair grants his request.

1 - AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING "POLICE UNIFORM ALLOTMENT ACCOUNT" AND REPEALING CHAPTER 1713 OF THE 1947 ORDINANCES.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

2 - AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING "FIRE UNIFORM ALLOTMENT ACCOUNT" AND REPEALING CHAPTER 1712 OF THE 1947 ORDINANCES.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Lazarus, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

3 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 422 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THIRTEEN THOUSAND EIGHTY (\$13,080) DOLLARS TO POLICE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 2.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

Mr. Lazarus moves to amend this Ordinance by appropriating the sum of \$21,800.00 in order to make the allowance \$100.00

for Police uniforms for each individual Police Officer.

There being no second to this amendment, the Chair declares the amendment not before the Committee.

The Chair then calls for a vote on the original Ordinance and Acting Chairman Laudati and Mr. Loughran vote "Aye". Mr. Lazarus is recorded as "Not Voting".

4 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 422 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FIVE (\$7,185) DOLLARS TO FIRE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 2.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

Mr. Lazarus moves to amend the Ordinance to make the allowance \$50.00 annually and to make the total appropriation \$11,975.00.

There being no second to the motion, the Chair declares the matter not before this Committee.

The Chair calls for a vote on this Ordinance and it is unanimously voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

5 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 422 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$200,000) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC WORKS-CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE DIVISION, HIGHWAY SECTION, ITEM 7.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

Mr. Lazarus moves to amend this Ordinance by transferring the sum of \$200,000.00 to public payrolls instead of to highways in order to increase the salaries of the employees of the City of Providence with the exception of the school teachers.

There being no second to this motion, the Chair declares the matter is not before the Committee.

Mr. Lazarus asks for a roll call vote. The same is granted and the Clerk calls the roll.

Acting Chairman Laudati and Mr. Loughran vote "Aye" and Mr. Lazarus is recorded as "Not Voting".

The Ordinance is then recommended for passage a first time.

6 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 422 BY DECREASING THE APPROPRIATION FOR GENERAL PUBLIC ASSISTANCE-UNALLOCATED, ITEM 3, BY THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND (\$330,000) DOLLARS.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Laudati, it is voted to return this Ordinance to the City Council with recommendation of passage a first time.

Mr. Lazarus calls for a roll call vote and the Clerk calls the roll as follows:

Acting Chairman Laudati and Mr. Loughran vote "Aye". Mr. Lazarus is recorded as "Not Voting".


The Ordinance is then recommended for passage a first time.
