The Finance Committee meets this day at 12:00 o'clock Noon.

Present: Messrs. Moakler, Loughran and Lazarus. Finance Director Cashman, City Treasurer Cardarelli and Assistant City Controller Hartigan are also present. (William E. McWilliams, Assistant Clerk)

The Clerk informs the Committee that Mr. Mariani will be unable to be present. Vice-Chairman Moakler takes the chair.

VICE-CHAIRMAN MOAKLER IN THE CHAIR

Finance Director Cashman outlines the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF THIRTY THOUSAND (\$30,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR RECORDER OF DEEDS, ITEM 1. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Thirty Thousand (\$30,000) Dollars is appropriated to Recorder of Deeds, Item 1, for microfilming the records of the Recorder of Deeds. Two copies of the films are to be made, one to be placed in downtown vault and one is to be used in Recorder's Office.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWO THOUSAND (\$2,000) DOLLARS TO TABULATING DIVISION, ITEM 5. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000) Dollars is appropriated to Tabulating Division, Item 5, for the purchase of air conditioning equipment. The tabulating equipment generates a high degree of heat, affecting not only the employees but also the efficiency of the machines and the cards used therefrom.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVENTY THOUSAND (\$70,000) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE DIVISION-BRIDGE MAINTENANCE SECTION, ITEM 7. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Seventy Thousand (\$70,000) Dollars is appropriated to Bridge Maintenance Section, Item 7. Twenty-five Thousand Dollars of this amount is to be used for redecking Merino Bridge; Thirty-five Thousand Dollars for replacing wooden fenders and dolphins at

Red Bridge; and Ten Thousand Dollars for building a Sanitation Building for employees and a Tool House at Red Bridge.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 2. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars is appropriated to Fire Department, Item 2, to be used for replacing some overhead wire which is in poor condition causing short circuits in the Fire Alarm System. This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY THOUSAND (\$20,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR BOARD OF CANVASSERS, ITEM 0. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000) Dollars is appropriated to Board of Canvassers, Item 0, to pay estimated cost of taking the census of persons who register to vote under the new permanent registration law.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWELVE THOUSAND (\$12,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR BATH HOUSES, ITEM 1. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Twelve Thousand (\$12,000) Dollars is appropriated to Bath Houses, Item 1. This amount is to be used for painting the interior and exterior of five Bath Houses and to repair fences and to replace window sash, water line and other necessary repairs.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR CITY SERGEANT, ITEM 1. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Forty-five Hundred Dollars is appropriated to City Sergeant, Item 1. This amount is to be used for rebricking boilers, roofing of elevator wells and minor repairs at City Hall.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF THIRTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$3,500) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR RECREATION DEPARTMENT, ITEM 5. (In City Council

December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time).

The sum of Thirty-five Hundred Dollars is appropriated to Recreation Department for the purchase of one 2-ton Dump Truck.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY-ONE THOUSAND (\$21,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR ROGER WILLIAMS PARK, ITEM 5. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Twenty-one Thousand Dollars is appropriated to Roger Williams Park, Item 5, to replace the following old equipment: two 4-ton Dump Trucks, one 12 foot Platform Body Truck with hoist and one Compressor.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVEN THOUSAND (\$7,000) DOLLARS TO PARKS GENERAL, ITEM 5. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Seven Thousand Dollars is appropriated to Parks General, Item 5, to replace one 3-ton Dump Truck.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$25,500) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR PUBLIC WORKS-CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE DIVISION-SEWER CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE SECTION, ITEM 5. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Twenty-five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars is appropriated to Sewer Construction and Maintenance Section, Item 7, for the purchase of one eductor truck and a 4" electric pump.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533 BY ADDING THE SUM OF TEN THOUSAND (\$10,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE, ITEMS 0, 2 AND 5. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Ten Thousand Dollars is appropriated to Municipal Golf Course. \$7,500.00 of this amount is to be used for improvement at the Golf Course as recommended by outside consultants. \$2,500.00 is to be used for replacement of equipment for power motors, rollers, etc.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$7,500) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR PARKS GENERAL, ITEMS 0 AND 2. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

December 17, 1951.

The sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars is appropriated to Parks General. This amount is to be used for the filling, grading, landscaping and planting on land extending from new Allens Avenue Fire Station to Ernest Street.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 533 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIFTY THOUSAND (\$50,000) DOLLARS TO PUBLIC WORKS-CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE DIVISION-HIGHWAYS SECTION, ITEM 7. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)

The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars is appropriated for Highway Section, Item 7 and is to be used for building streets in the Hartford Avenue Housing Project.

This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 533, BY ADDING THE SUM OF FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATION CONTAINED THEREIN FOR RECREATION DEPARTMENT, ITEMS 1 AND 2. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time)


The sum of Five Thousand Dollars is appropriated to Recreation Department and is to be used for improving area at Camp and Cypress Streets, making it suitable for a junior size baseball diamond. This sum is obtained from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER 534 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951. (In City Council December 6, 1951. Read and passed the first time.)

This Ordinance gives the Board of Canvassers authority with the approval of the Mayor, the Finance Director and Personnel Director, to employ the necessary number of temporary employees during the registration of voters.

On motion of Mr. Loughran, seconded by Mr. Moakler, it is voted to recommend for passage a second time, the above enumerated Ordinances.
